



1. Prepare a pendrive (flash memory) for upgrade. Copy the update file to the pendrive and place it in the directory named **upgrade** (create new directory if necessary).



2. Put the pendrive in AMI USB socket (A.) while the interface is working. Use the switch on power cable (B.) to make USB the active source (when the USB is active source, You should see a list of files and directories of USB device).



3. Press the switch on the power cable (B.) and hold it for 10 to 15 seconds. The AMI will switch to the iPod source mode and then the MMI unit itself will reboot.

4. After the MMI reboots, AMI will initialize in its bootloader (the diode on the interface will stop blinking) and if upgrade file was valid, the actualization will proceed. After the actualization is done, the AMI will swicth back to normal mode automatically.
